JUDGES	Same plan as 2024. Katie Hobbs is still Gov and could make even worse judge replacements. Vote YES on all judges (rehire) EXCEPT vote NO on the following: Suzanna Pineda – Formal Code of Conduct Reprimand (see website for details) ... Elections have consequences. We must elect Andy Biggs as AZ Governor. Then many more conservative judges will be appointed. NOTE: CS reviewed judges based the 2026 Judicial Performance Review (peer & citizen) and other formal reviews that assess judicial conduct. Historical data shows removing judges at the ballot box is a rare event. The most effective way to improve the judiciary is by electing a conservative governor who - by law - makes judge appointments and populates judicial screening and review functions with conservatives. Full AZ law resp. req’d YES Prop 318 – No Boys in Girls Bathrooms – Bans biological males in girls' sports, locker rooms & bathrooms. YES Prop 319 – Traffic Camera Ban – Bans photo radar / red-light cams. Existing cams req voter approval. YES Prop 320 – Spend on Students – Require 60%+ of school funds to be spent in classroom, not for Admin. YES Prop 413 – 0.2% Jail Tax – Renews tax for 20 yrs., the 0.2% sales tax that funds MC jails (\$300M/yr rev) NO Scottsdale USD \$375M Bond – Declining enrollment / schools are closing. No clear plan, just a big number. YES Scottsdale USD School Site Sale – Authorize selling three (3) closed campuses (Cholla, Apache, Oak) NO FH USD Budget Override – Renews operating funds for education and operating exp (+0.1675% tax) NO PV USD Budget Override – Renews operating funds for education and operating exp (+0.5827% tax) NO PV USD Dist Added Asst Override – Added operating funds for education and operating exp (+0.1334% tax) YES Cave Creek School Site Sale – Authorize sale of Desert Sun campus (closed)
